

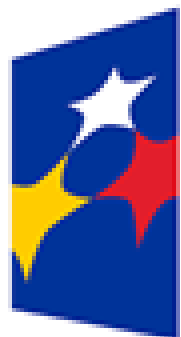

The monastery is being renovated. Was destroyed by the Nazis. Located in a wonderful place. You can walk around the building and around it.



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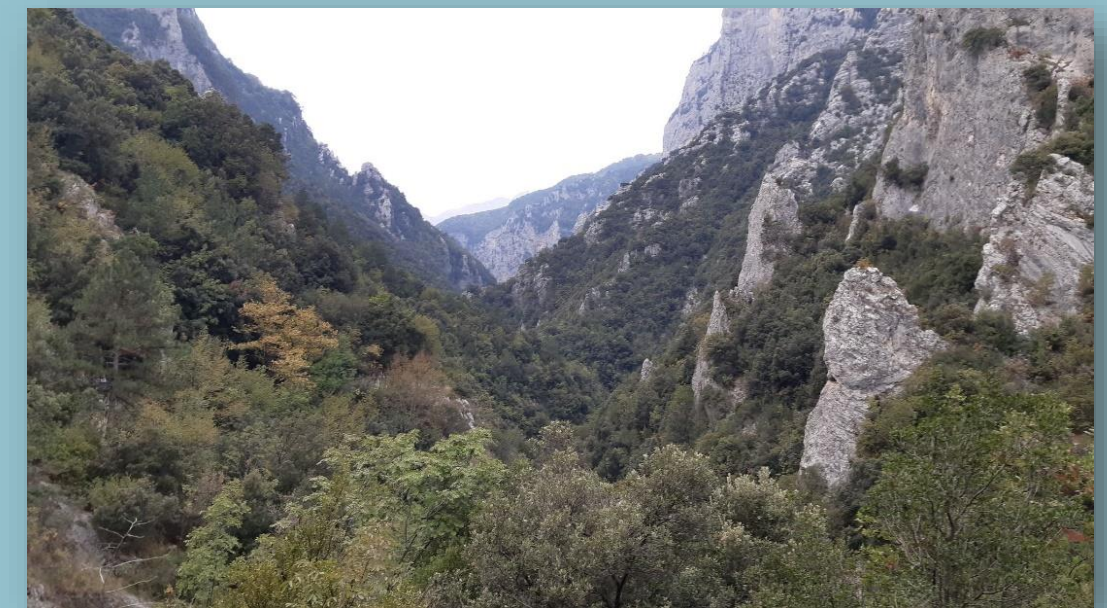
We went to Platamonas city. We had a chance to walk around the harbour, which was lit by blue lights, which gave it a lot of charm. We got some time to look around and gather material for our sites. At the end we gathered the Greeks and together we danced Belgian and Zorba.

We went to the archaeological museum in Dion where we had the opportunity to break through our language barrier by introducing ourselves. We showed our new friends what we were interested in, sang a song and made a drill show.



Our trips

During the trips, we not only visited new places, but also learned about Greek traditions and the Greek language.



We were in the Olympic National Park, where we walked the mountain trail to the place where Zeus was taking a bath.



We went on a trip to the Meteors. It is a complex of monasteries located high in the mountains inhabited by monks. In order to enter the monasteries, women must have their arms and legs covered, and if they do not, they must buy a colourful headscarf.



We visited also the city of Katerini, where we met with Greeks. During the trips, we not only visited new places, but also learned about Greek traditions and the Greek language and met students from Platon School. We could visit the city and try dishes and delicacies.



We could enjoy cruising the ship "Elizabeth", sailed to the island where we visited a small monastery and could admire the beautiful views. During the break we could jump from the ship straight into turquoise water or kayak. We had the opportunity to learn some traditional Greek dances on the lower deck. During the cruise we saw dolphins jumping over the water surface.

Self-presentation lessons

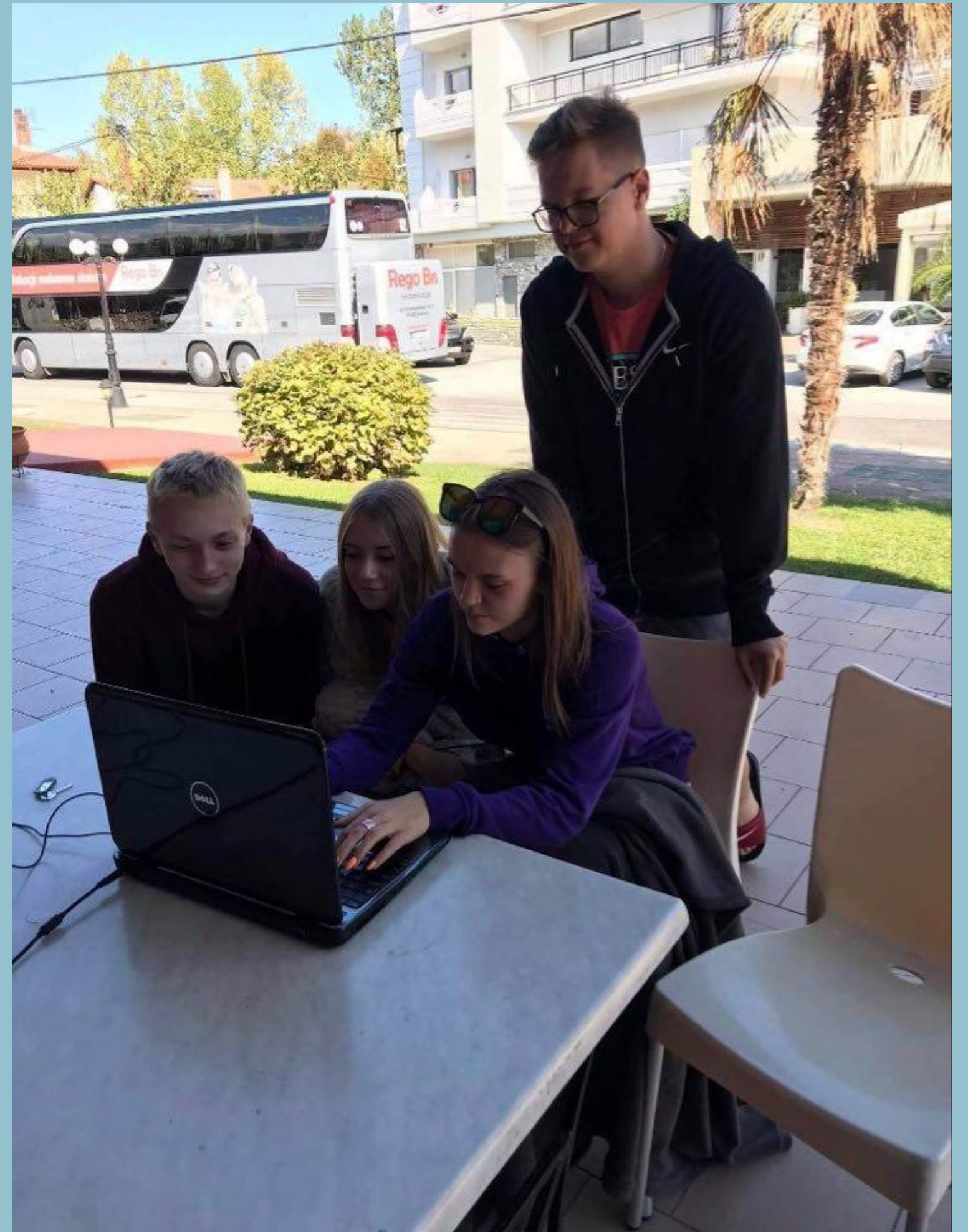

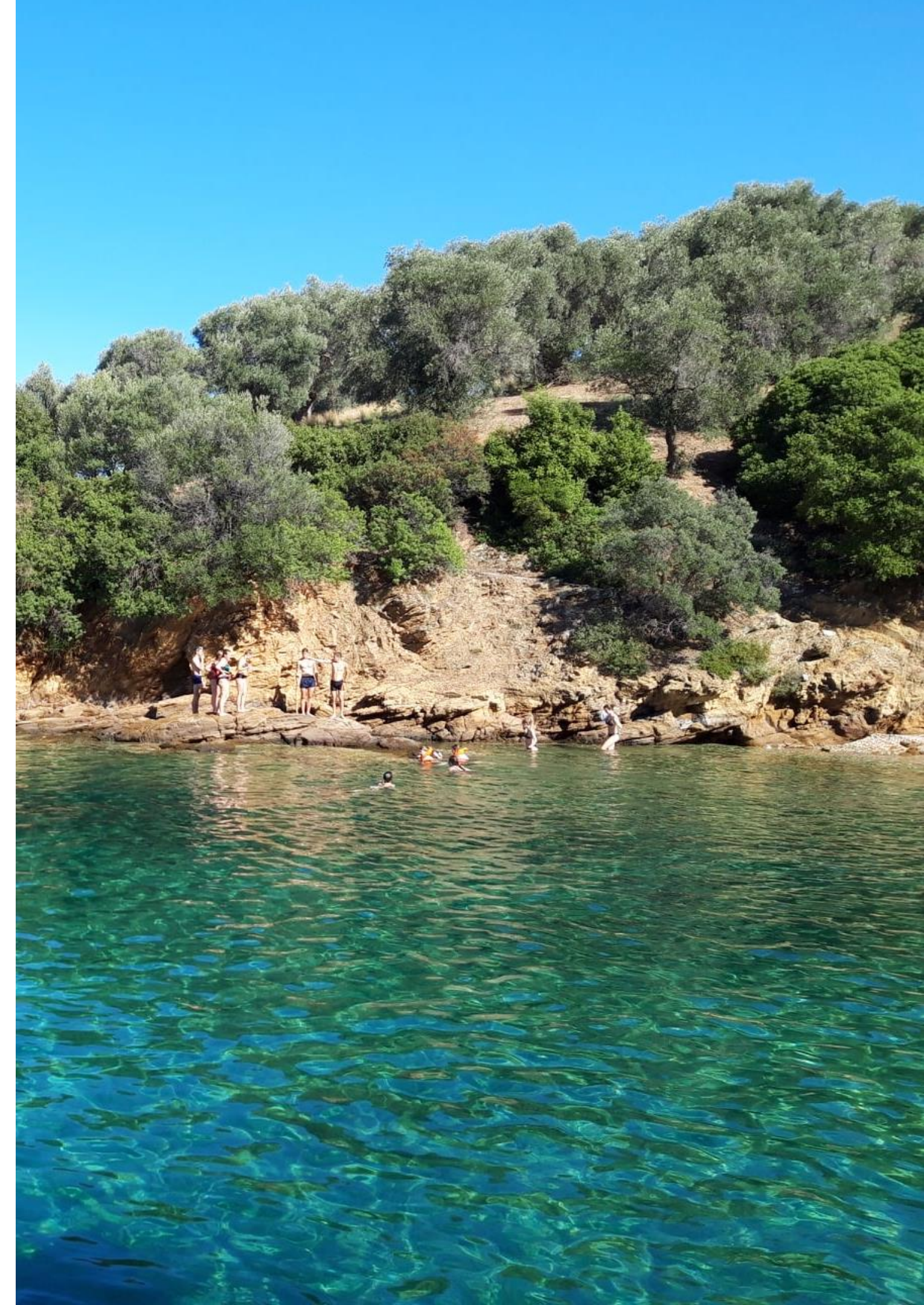

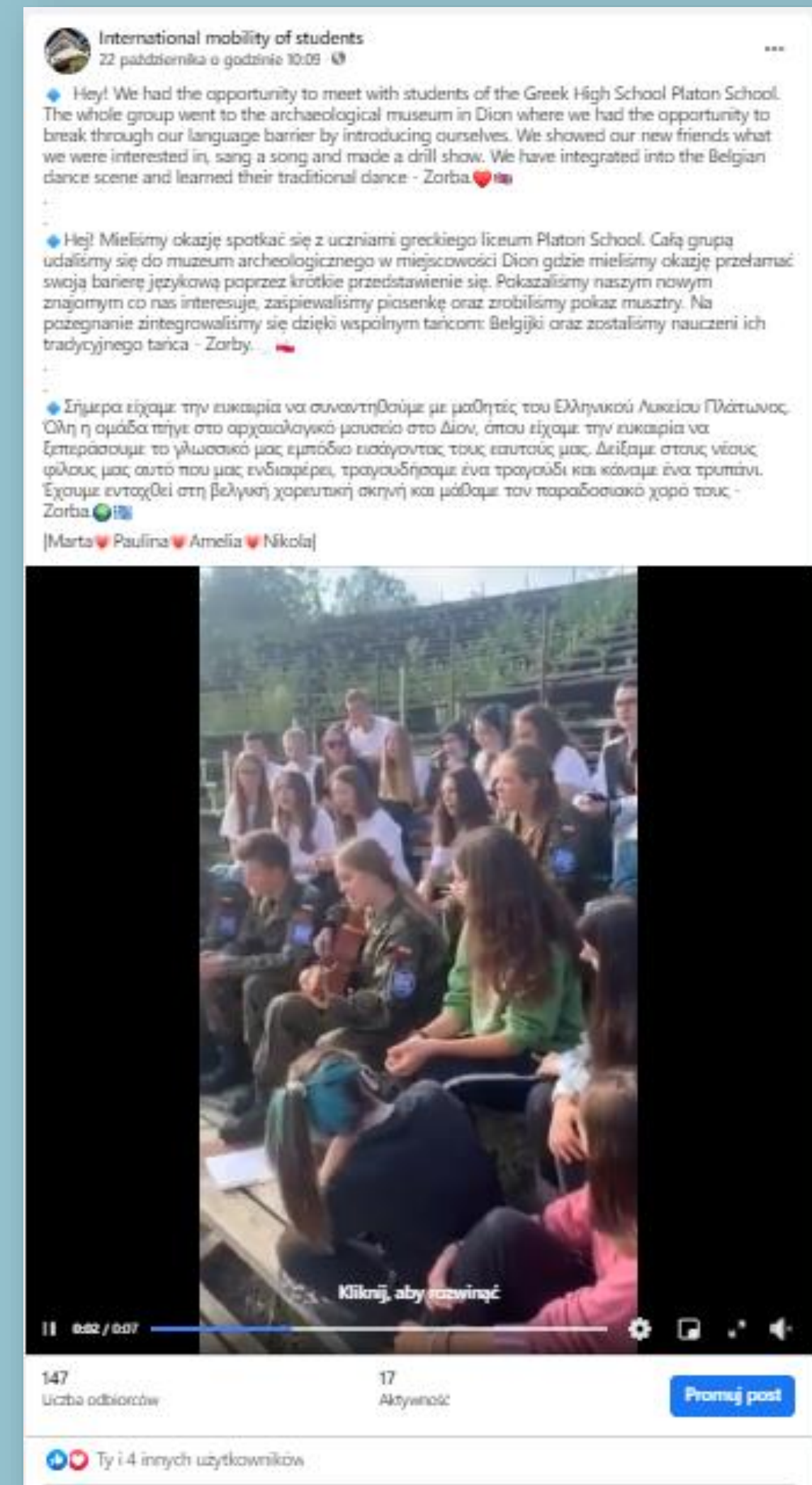
International mobility of students
